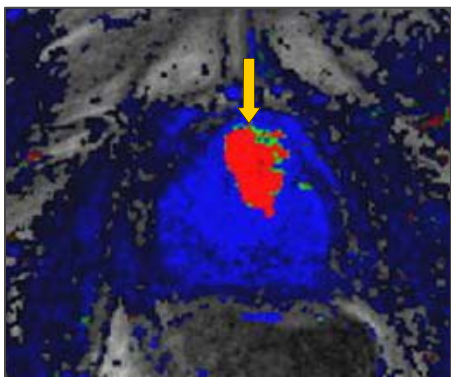
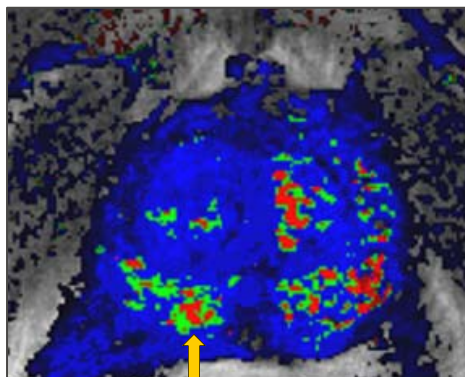


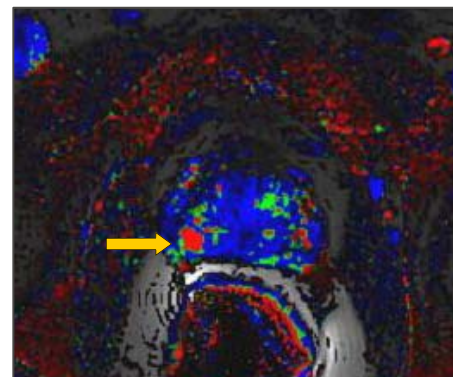
PROSTATE MRI

INDICATIONS:

- Unexplained rise in PSA, with history of prior benign biopsies.
- Local and regional extent of disease in patients with known prostate carcinoma.
- Follow-up after treatment, including unexplained rise in PSA after all kinds of treatment for prostate carcinoma.

WHAT PHYSICIANS AND PATIENTS NEED TO KNOW:

- Examination is performed with intravenous contrast.
- Data is processed using special software which aids in the detection of abnormal enhancement and the location of findings is reported in relation to anatomic landmarks.
- Examination can be performed with or without an endorectal coil for added patient comfort and compliance.
- For all patients, the prep includes no sexual activity for 72 hours. Fleet enemas prior to examination are also recommended if the use of an endorectal coil is anticipated.
- Bone scans can be arranged to be performed at the same facility on the same day.

MRI GUIDED PROSTATE BIOPSY: A cutting edge technology. We are the first on Long Island to perform MRI guided biopsy of the prostate which facilitates diagnosis in patients with unexplained rise in PSA and benign traditional biopsy results, and in patients with suspicious findings on post-treatment studies.
